DECIMALS

Addition and subtraction of decimals

- To add or subtract decimals, align the digits according to their place values.
- Arrange the decimals vertically with the decimal point at the centre.

Example 1

Work out $352.534+0.5982+0.08$

Solution

- Align the decimals according to their place values.

$$\begin{array}{r} 1\ 11 \\ 352.5340 \\ 0.5982 \\ + \underline{0.0800} \\ \hline 353.1322 \end{array}$$

Example 2

Work out $826.39- 20.009$

Solution

- Align the decimals according to their place values.

$$\begin{array}{r} 826.390 \\ - \underline{20.009} \\ \hline \underline{806.381} \end{array}$$

Relief services.

Relief services are the assistance given to a disaster victim.

What the government, church, individuals and non-governmental organizations do to the disaster victims is what we call **relief services**.

Disaster is things like famine, fire outbreak, drought floods, diseases, epidemics and wars.

The victims of natural disasters are helped by non-governmental organizations [NGOs] and individuals.

These organizations can help in the following ways:

- Donating basic needs i.e. food, clothes, shelter, water and also medical care.
- Training the victims in skills such as basketry e.t.c.
- Offering comfort through prayers.

Other Christian Organizations that offer relief services include:

- The Catholic Relief Services.
- Children's Christian Fund. [CCF]
- CARE International.
- Jesuit Relief Services.
- Christian AID
- Medical Research Foundation [AMREF]

1corinthians 16:1-3

-The church was concerned about christens who were facing hardship.

-Christians at Corinth wrote to Paul in order to contribute to the people of God in Judaea.

-Paul told them to copy the example of the people of Galatia.

-The bible encourages Christians to raise funds and save to help disaster victims.

Care for the refugees.

A refugee is anyone who flees his or her country to another country due to political, unrest, famine, religious conflict or wars.

In Kenya there are many refugees from neighboring countries.

Christians come together to help such people in the country.

Refugees live in camps. Some of these camps include; Kakuma refugee camp and Dadaab in northern parts of Kenya.

The main church organizations for refugees are:

-National council churches of Kenya (NCCCK)

- Anglican Church of Kenya (ACK)

- Presbyterian church of east African (PCEA)

- Seventh day Adventist (SDA)

- The Kenya Episcopal Conference.(KEC) which is made up catholic Bishops of Kenya

The NCCCK and KEC work hand in hand with organizations that deals with refugees

United Nations High commission for refugees (UNHCR)

All Africa conference of churches (AACC)

The world council of churches (WCC)

All these organizations with other Christians in Kenya care for the refugees by:

- Providing material resources such as water, food and clothing.
- Providing shelter, education and health services.
- Providing spiritual nourishment
- Offering counsel and encouragement to refugees.
- Visiting refugees in their camps and offering emotional support

Matthew 5:16-26

Christians should use their resources including money to help those in need.

Christians working together

- Christians of St. Paul church worked together.
