DECIMALS

Multiplication of Decimals

Example 1

Work out 5.137×2.3

Solution

Method 1

1. The two decimals have 4 decimal places.
2. Express each decimal as a fraction and find their product.

$$\frac{5137}{1000} \times \frac{23}{10} = \frac{118151}{10000}$$

3. Move the decimal point four places to the left.

$$5.137 \times 2.3 = 11.8151$$

$$= 11.8151$$

Method 2

1. Ignore the decimal places and find their product as whole numbers.
2. Count the number of decimal places (4)

$$\begin{array}{r}
 5137 \\
 \times 23 \\
 \hline
 15411 \\
 102740 \\
 \hline
 118151
 \end{array}$$

3. Move the decimal point four places to the left.

$$1.137 \times 2.3 = 11.8151$$
